The annual election for members of the Los Angeles County Committee on School District Organization (County Committee) was held on October 3, 2022. The County Committee appreciates your support and wishes to thank the school and community college districts that submitted nominations, and all who participated in the election process, either as candidates, or as governing board representatives.

Election Results

First Supervisorial District (one vacancy)

Mr. John Quintanilla was elected to a four-year term, and will serve as one of the representatives of the First Supervisorial District through December 2026.

Mr. Quintanilla is currently in the At-Large seat on the County Committee. The County Committee will be appointing his replacement after he is sworn into his new seat on January 4, 2023 in the 1st Supervisorial District.

Mr. Quintanilla is currently on the board of Rosemead School District (SD).

Fourth Supervisorial District (one vacancy)

There will be a runoff election between incumbent Ms. Martha Deutsch and candidate Ms. Lisa Dabbs, as neither of them received a majority of the votes cast between the three candidates who had ran. A bulletin with instructions for districts to cast their ballots is forthcoming.
