SUBJECT: 2022-23 Fourth Quarter Accrual and 2023-24 Lottery Revenue Projections

The California Department of Education (CDE) has released the fourth quarter accrual for 2022-23, and the 2023-24 lottery revenue projections.

### **2022-23 FOURTH QUARTER ACCRUAL**

Based on the updated lottery sales projection from the California State Lottery Commission (CSLC), the CDE estimates 2022-23 lottery revenues to be \$204.10 per unit of average daily attendance (ADA) for unrestricted and \$99.90 per ADA for restricted. The lottery apportionments from the first through the third quarter totaled \$171.64 per ADA unrestricted, and \$69.91 per ADA restricted. Therefore, the CDE recommends accruing the 2022-23 fourth quarter lottery revenues using \$32.47 per ADA unrestricted, and \$30.00 per ADA restricted. Amounts owed to the State for prior year adjustments will be offset against the apportionment and should be considered when booking the fourth quarter accrual. Amounts due are listed in the third quarter State Controller's Office (SCO) Master Register, under the Accounts Receivable Balance column, and are broken down by non-Proposition 20 and Proposition 20. ### **2023-24 LOTTERY REVENUE PROJECTIONS**

For 2023-24, the California State Lottery Commission (CSLC) projects lottery sales to reach \$8.7 billion, providing education with \$1.79 billion. The CDE projects this level of revenue would result in a total estimated 2023-24 lottery rate of \$249 per ADA (\$177 per ADA unrestricted, and \$72 per ADA restricted).

## 2022–23 Lottery Fourth Quarter Accrual 2023–24 Lottery Revenue Projections

The following Lottery accrual and revenue projections are offered for your information as you prepare year-end statements and update your budgets.

### 2022–23 Fourth Quarter Accrual

Based on the California State Lottery Commission's (CSLC) year-end projections for fiscal year 2022–23, the California Department of Education (CDE) estimates Lottery revenues to be \$204.10 per unit of average daily attendance (ADA) for non-Proposition 20 (unrestricted revenues) and \$99.90 per ADA for Proposition 20 revenues.

As of June 28, 2023, the total amounts apportioned through the third quarter are \$171.636748849 per ADA in non-Proposition 20 unrestricted revenues and \$69.908322532 per ADA in Proposition 20 revenues. The CDE recommends accruals for the fourth quarter to be \$32.47 per ADA for the unrestricted Lottery apportionment and \$30.00 per ADA for the Proposition 20 apportionment. In summary:

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If funds are owed to the state for prior year adjustments, these amounts will be offset against the apportionment and should be taken into consideration when booking the fourth quarter accrual. Amounts due are listed under the Accounts Receivable Balance column of the Master Register and are broken down by non-Proposition 20 and Proposition 20. The third quarter State Controller's Office (SCO) Master Register on the SCO's web page at [https://www.sco.ca.gov/ard\\_payments\\_lottery.html](https://www.sco.ca.gov/ard_payments_lottery.html) provides information on amounts due.

## 2023–24 Lottery Revenue Projections

The CSLC is projecting total Lottery sales of \$8.7 billion for 2023–24 and estimates that this level of sales will result in \$1.79 billion for education. Based on these projections, the CDE estimates that the lottery will provide the following estimated rates:

We will monitor actual sales each quarter and advise you of any changes to the projection. The CDE requests that county superintendents of schools inform LEAs immediately of this information.
