Subject: CalPERS Reporting Out-of-Class Hours (GC Section 20480) – 2021-22

This bulletin serves as a reminder that each district is required to report “out-of-class” hours to the California Public Employees’ Retirement System (CalPERS). This mandate is an **annual** reporting requirement that pertains to both CalPERS **Classic and PEPPRA** members. **The reporting is due by July 30, 2022.**

Effective January 1, 2018, Assembly Bill (AB) 1487 added Government Code (GC) Section 20480 requiring agencies to report hours worked in out-of-class positions. As of July 1, 2019, CalPERS requires out-of-class hours to be uploaded into my|CalPERS. Each district will receive CalPERS notification letters as follows:

- 1) **Annual Notice:** CalPERS sent a letter in June advising employers that the out-of-class hours reporting is due by July 30th each year.
- 2) **Failure to Comply Notice:** CalPERS will send this letter in August to employers that did not submit the out-of-class hours report.

Action:

Refer to the Los Angeles County Office of Education (LACOE) [Bulletin No. 5402](#) dated June 30, 2021 for instructions on how to report the hours to CalPERS. Employers are required to submit the hours for each fiscal year.
