SUBJECT: CalPERS Reporting Out-of-Class Hours (GC Section 20480) – 2023-24

This bulletin is a reminder that each district is required to report out-of-class hours to the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS). This mandate is an **annual** reporting that pertains to CalPERS **Classic and PEPR** members. **Fiscal year 2023-24 reporting is due by July 30, 2024.**

Effective January 1, 2018, Assembly Bill (AB) 1487 added Government Code (GC) Section 20480 which requires agencies to report hours worked in out-of-class positions. As of July 1, 2019, CalPERS requires out-of-class hours reporting to be uploaded into my|CalPERS. Each district will receive CalPERS notification letters directly as follows:

- 1) Annual Notice: CalPERS will send a letter in June to advise employers that the out-of-class hours reporting is due by July 30th each year.
- 2) Failure to Comply Notice: CalPERS will send this letter in August to employers that did not submit the out-of-class hours report.

Note: Submit the Out-of-Class Hours Report even if the Annual Notice/Failure to Comply Notice was not received.

District Action:
