SUBJECT: Biennial Governing Board Member Elections - November 3, 2026

Pursuant to Education Code (EC) §5000, elections will be held on November 3, 2026, to elect members to the governing boards in some school and community college districts in Los Angeles County. A blanket “Order of Election,” which will cover all governing board elections held on this date, will be issued by this office and transmitted to the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (Registrar-Recorder). **Governing boards of districts scheduled to hold elections on this date are required to take action to initiate the regular biennial governing board election by adopting the attached resolution (Attachment 1).** In accordance with EC §5340, such governing board elections are required to be consolidated.

Some districts with board elections that are governed by city charters that call for elections on dates other than November 3, 2026, will be working directly with their City Clerks, the Registrar-Recorder and the Los Angeles County Office of Education’s (LACOE’s) team in Business Advisory Services. Many of the City Clerks will request the Registrar-Recorder to perform some of the required procedures. Therefore, early contact with the appropriate City Clerk is essential.

Those districts with elections set by city charters and handled by the Registrar-Recorder are asked to have their governing boards order their election for the date set forth in their charters. These orders are to be sent directly to LACOE at least 130 days before the election; LACOE staff will transmit a copy to the Registrar-Recorder. Please refer to the attachment titled “Governing Board Member Elections - Districts Under City Charters” (Attachment 2) and “Governing Board Member Elections - Districts Not Under City Charters” (Attachment 3) for the prescribed election date for your district.

For your information, we have also included a copy of the most recent (as of the date of this bulletin) “2026 Scheduled Elections,” from the Registrar-Recorder’s office (Attachment 4). It is important to note that **the listing of scheduled elections frequently changes; districts should check it regularly as their election date approaches.** To assist you, we are providing the following link: [2026 Scheduled Elections Listing](#)

Please review the membership of your district's governing board carefully and construct the election resolutions accordingly, paying attention to the number of seats up for election (including additional seats necessary to fill a partial term for a vacancy), any relevant trustee areas for those seats, and the terms of current board members. If your board made a vacancy appointment in 2025 or in 2026 for a governing board member seat expiring in November 2028, the latter two years of the term must be filled by Special Election, which will be consolidated with the November 2026 General Election. The Special Election resolution to fill the two-year seat must be separate from your board's regularly scheduled election resolution which is to fill new four-year terms for seats expiring in November 2026.

Please return the adopted resolution and information indicating two newspapers in your area that can be used by the Registrar-Recorder to print a Notice of Election by **May 8, 2026**.

Before May 2026, the Registrar-Recorder should send you information related to candidates' statements. Board action will be required regarding the information contained in that letter. A calendar outlining the dates and processes related to the governing board member elections will be issued by the Registrar-Recorder in July 2026. The Registrar-Recorder may be in contact with you regarding the regional voting centers, and the Voting Solutions for All People (VSAP) procedures. RESOLUTION ORDERING GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER ELECTION

RESOLVED that pursuant to Education Code (EC) §§5000-5030, the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools (County Superintendent) is hereby ORDERED to call an election for the purpose, and in accordance with the designations contained in the following specifications of the Election Order made under the authority of EC §5302, §5304, and §5322.

SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER

The election shall be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026. The polling hours shall be from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on multiple days at the Voting Centers leading up to Election Day.

The purpose of the election is to submit to the voters of the district the question of whether _____ members shall be elected to the Governing Board of the _____ District.

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (Registrar-Recorder) will perform all the duties incident to the preparation for and holding of the above-mentioned election. The District will pay the costs of the election. If any agency holds an election on November 3, 2026, the _____ District shall pay its pro rata share pertaining to the conduct of this election and shall be under the provisions of the appropriate sections of the Education and Election Codes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the district is hereby directed to furnish two copies of this order to the County Superintendent not less than 130 days prior to the date set for the election.
