LA County Superintendent of Schools Statement on Texas school shooting

As mothers, fathers, caregivers, and educators, mere words cannot adequately express the pain and devastation of today's tragic shooting of 14 children and a teacher at a Texas elementary school. My heart aches for the families, students, educators and community members of Robb Elementary School and all our education communities.

It is inconceivable and unconscionable that we continue to experience these horrific acts of violence in communities across our country. In our collective shock and grief, we must continue to take care of ourselves and one another and act with sensitivity, compassion, and empathy as we engage in conversations in the coming days.

Schools must be safe spaces in our communities—both physically and emotionally—where our children may learn and grow. As children, youth, and adults hear about this tragedy, are triggered or impacted by what they hear, have questions, and for need to talk about what has happened, we have put together some resources that will be helpful. Focusing on the mental health of our students, staff, and families must continue to be a priority in our schools.
