

Why Do You Need To Understand CTE Credentials?

*"If a teacher does not possess the <u>appropriate</u> CTE credential, the grantee cannot expend CTEIG or Perkins monies on this teacher's program."* 







# What Is A Preliminary CTE Credential?

- Teaching in middle school, high school, charter school, adult school, ROCP, or other training school
- Issued for three years; must apply for clear before expiration
- CTE subject authorization(s) based on industry work experience and background
- Subject authorizations for CTE = 15 industry sectors





### **CTE Subjects/Industry Sectors**

Agriculture and Natural Resources	Arts, Media, and Entertainment	Building and Construction Trades	Business and Finance	Education, Child Development, and Family Services
Energy, Environment, and Utilities	Engineering and Architecture	Fashion and Interior Design	Health Science and Medical Technology	Hospitality, Tourism, and Recreation
Information and Communication Technologies	Manufacturing and Product Development	Marketing, Sales, and Services	Public Services	Transportation



- Allows teaching <u>only</u> specific CTE subject(s)
- Example: Fashion and Interior Design sector
- Cosmetology versus Upholstering
- Employer responsible for determining which CTE subjects
- **Some CTE subjects fall in different industry sectors**
- Example: Robotics
- \* Warning! CTC subjects not fully aligned with CTE MCS
- Example: Animation



### How To Qualify For A Preliminary CTE Credential

3 years industry experience (1000 hours of paid or unpaid experience = 1 year) 2 years industry experience <u>and</u> 24 units in the subject <u>or</u> industry certification 1 year industry experience <u>and</u> 48 units in the subject <u>or</u> 24 units + industry certification

**OPTION 3** 





At least one year of work experience within the last five years or two years within the last ten years

Also met with postsecondary vocational training or occupational internship or prior teaching experience



### **Work Experience Documentation**

Document work experience on employer
 letterhead with original signature

Sample work experience letter in packet

Self-employed needs notarized letter + five documents

### **Other Requirements**





- High school graduation or GED or college degree
- License (if applicable, i.e., nursing, cosmetology)
- Fingerprints/Live Scan
- Certificate of Clearance (apply at ctc.ca.gov and pay \$52.50 online)
- ¢TC 41-4
- LACOE information form and data survey
- Intent to complete clear credential requirements
- LACOE processing fee (\$100 money order or cashier's check)
- CTC fee paid online later (additional \$52.50 or \$102.50 if prior credentials held in CA)

For Teachers With Single Subject Credentials (in non-career technical subjects)

May qualify for a CTE credential with:
✓ Minimum of 1 year of industry experience
(1000 hours of paid/unpaid experience = 1 year) +
✓ 24 semester units in the subject listed on the CTE credential <u>or</u> industry certification +
✓ Full time teaching – any subject for 1 year



- ➢ IF NEVER CREDENTIALED PREVIOUSLY IN CA, MUST APPLY FOR CERTICATE OF CLEARANCE BEFORE APPLYING TO LACOE. GO TO CTC.CA.GOV AND APPLY ONLINE (FEE \$52.50).
- Preliminary CTE Credential application to LACOE
- Applicant receives LACOE recommendation by email
- LACOE recommends to CTC
- CTC sends email from <u>donotreply@ctc.ca.gov</u>
- Follow CTC email directions to complete processing
- CTC approves credential (2-3 weeks)





### **Teaching English Learners**

 Preliminary CTE Credential does <u>not</u> include authorization to teach English Learners
 District must file a waiver each year with CTC
 Will be qualified when CTE credential is cleared
 Exception: Took SDAIE and received CCSD

Requirements to Clear A Preliminary CTE Credential (Within Three Years)

Completion of Early Orientation and Professional Preparation Coursework

- Two years (four semesters) of Teaching Experience <u>after</u> preliminary CTE credential issuance
- Two semesters of Supervisor Program Evaluations and Contact Logs

Two semesters of Mentor Observations and Feedback Logs

**US** Constitution (course or exam)

**CPR Certification (for Adult and Pediatric)** 





### **CTE Professional Preparation Coursework**

University of San Diego Professional & Continuing Education

**Online Courses** 

Classroom Management Curriculum Teaching English Learners 7 weeks – 3 semester credits

Teaching Portfolio 5 weeks – 2 semester credits Health Education for Teachers 1 week – 1 semester credit

Four terms per year Winter, Spring, Summer, Fall Twice per term



# **Clear CTE Credential Application**



□ *Transcripts* for completed coursework

- Letter verifying two years (four semesters) of *Teaching Experience* <u>after</u> preliminary CTE credential issuance
- Two semesters of Supervisor Program Evaluations and Contact Logs
- Two semesters of Mentor Observations and Feedback Logs
- Transcript for US Constitution course or proof of exam
- **CPR Certification (for Adult and Pediatric)**
- LACOE \$100 fee, LACOE information and data forms, CTC 41-4 and professional fitness questions, copy of preliminary CTE credential
- **LACOE** recommends to CTC
- CTC sends email from donotreply@ctc.ca.gov
- Follow CTC email directions to complete payment and processing
- **CTC** approves credential (2-3 weeks)






## **Clear CTE Credential Renewal**

- Clear CTE credential issued for five years
- Renew online with CTC for \$100
- English Learner authorization S17C:

Career Technical Education (CTE) Preliminary Designated Subjects For first-time credential applicants (even if you hold a credential in another state, you are still considered a first-time applicant in California)....Read more

Adult Education Preliminary (Academic or non-Academic) Designated Subjects For applicants with a California credential already on file with the Commission on Teacher Credentialing...Read more

#### Adult Education "Clear" Designated Subjects

For applicants "dearing" a Preliminary Adult Education Credential after completing all coursework and credential requirements [only for Preliminary AE Credentials issued after January 31, 2013 under "new regulations"]. ...Read more



#### Supervision and Coordination For applicants with a clear full-time AE or CTE credential who have completed the Level 3



course and the CBEST (California Basic Education Skills Test). [Note: This credential is accepted only by some ROCPs and Adult Schools for specific supervisory positions.]...Read

Adult Education, Career Technical Education, Supervision and Coordination Credentials

Los Angeles County Office of Education - Career Technical Education (LACDE-CTE) is an approved Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) Program Sponsor for the Designated Subjects (DS) Credentials in Career Technical Education, Adult Education, and Supervision and Coordination. The Designated Subjects Credentials Unit processes the Preliminary and Clear Career Technical Education and Adult Education Oredentials as well as the Supervision and Coordination Gredential for qualified candidates. In collaboration with the University of San Diego (USD), LACOE-CTE provides a sequence of coursework. that prepares candidates to become successful and effective Adult Education and Career Technical Education teachers, supervisors and coordinators.
