A meeting of the Los Angeles County Board of Education was held on Tuesday, November 12, 2024, at the Los Angeles County Office of Education Board Room.

**PRESENT:** Dr. Yvonne Chan, Mr. James Cross, Mrs. Andrea Foggy-Paxton, Ms. Betty Forrester, Dr. Theresa Montaña, and Dr. Stanley L. Johnson, Jr.; Student Board Member: Ms. Jimena

**OTHERS PRESENT:** Dr. Debra Duardo, Superintendent; Administrative Staff: Ms. Beatrice Robles, Principal Executive Assistant, Office of the Superintendent.

**STUDY SESSION:** There was a Study Session on Universal Pre-K and Career Development. Dr. Maricela Ramirez and team provided a presentation to the County Board.

The County Board had questions related to this Study Session.

Ms. Marian Thomas addressed the County Board during Public Comment.

**PRELIMINARY ACTIVITIES**

**CALL TO ORDER**

Dr. Johnson called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

Dr. Johnson read the LACOE Land Acknowledgement.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

Mrs. Foggy-Paxton led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**ORDERING OF THE AGENDA**

Dr. Duardo indicated that Interdistrict Attendance Appeals Nos. 4, 7 and 8 had been resolved.

It was **MOVED** by Dr. Chan, **SECONDED** by Mr. Cross, and **CARRIED** to approve the Board agenda as amended.

**APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES -**

- October 15, 2024 – *The minutes were approved as presented.*

It was **MOVED** by Mr. Cross, **SECONDED** by Dr. Montano, and **CARRIED** to approve the October 15, 2024 minutes as presented.

### **COMMUNICATIONS: BOARD / SUPERINTENDENT**

Ms. Jimena said it was good to be back in person to the Board meeting. She thanked the Board and Cabinet for her upcoming trip to New York and said she was excited about going to explore colleges/universities.

Ms. Jimena said that LACHSA had an event for new students at LACHSA and were interested in learning about the school, programs and events. She had a great time being involved in the event.

Ms. Jimena said she attended the HOPE Event on Saturday, October 26, 2024. She said that the conference event aimed to amplify the voices of our Latina/o/x students from Renaissance, IPoly, and LACHSA. Students shared their thoughts on the upcoming election and policy issues concerning their communities. Ms. Jimena said that Dr. Theresa Montañó was the keynote speaker and spoke about historical barriers and accomplishments within the Latina/o/x communities and the importance of political representation. Ms. Jimena said she was happy to be able to share her own experience as a student board member.

Dr. Chan said she is excited to travel alongside Ms. Jimena on her trip to New York and visiting schools.

Dr. Chan said that on October 21, 2024 she participated in the Greater LA Training on Mandated Reporter Initiative. She said that the event was well attended and stressed the importance for all sites to get trained. She said she was impressed that Dr. Tyrone Howard attended.

Mr. Cross said he wanted to address the election and results. He expects many changes to take place and hopes that LACOE can filter what is happening so that student, families and staff know what the truth is and what can be done, especially information on education and standards for classroom content.

Mrs. Foggy-Paxton said she also attended the Greater LA Education Foundation event, which was great.

Dr. Montano also shared the HOPE Event and said that she left the event with a sense of hope. She said that she was saddened to hear from LACOE about discriminatory text messages that were sent out the African American students on the weekend and thanked Dr. Duardo for her leadership in taking the time to send out an email to districts about this issue and offer a calm and united front that this is not okay.

Dr. Perez indicated that the Mandated Report training was excellent and thanked Ms. Garoupa and staff for the event.

Dr. Perez said that he has taken a job at East Los Angeles College beginning in January 2025 and that unfortunately, he must resign from LACOE as Board Members. He said that

Supervisor Horvath is already looking for a replacement. He thanked the County Board and said that the group is phenomenal. He mentioned that he was not happy to hear about the discriminatory text messages being sent out and is happy to hear that LACOE will do everything possible to keep students safe.

Dr. Johnson said that he attended the GLAEF event, which was great. He said he has been thinking about the results of the election and that it will be important that the Board thinks strategically and collectively related to restrictions that will be forthcoming. He said that what the Board does and how they frame strategy, will need to be collective. Dr. Johnson said that equity will not change.

Dr. Duardo provided the following highlights to the County Board:

### **Post Election Message**

- We're more committed than ever to making sure we address divisiveness, hate and ugly rhetoric.
- We're already receiving messages of concern from our immigrant populations -- from people who are concerned about their status.
- We have more work to do together to address the fears of students.
- We are going to continue our mission to support all children to make sure they have a safe place in schools where they feel they belong.

Dr. Duardo thanked everyone who attended the Superintendent's Collaborative and said it was a wonderful event. Dr. Duardo thanked Ms. Naime Laskar and the Public Affairs and Communications Team.

Dr. Duardo said she is proud of Ms. Jimena and excited for her and her upcoming trip to New York.
