CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Chan called the meeting to order at 3:06 p.m.

Ms. Jimena said AP Testing taking place at LACHSA as well as finals, which is the main focus right now.

Ms. Jocelyn said it was great to see Dr. Ramirez last week. She said that she is excited about working with staff at school to put together a prom for students.

Mr. Cross said he received an invitation to attend a seminar on Proposition 28, which provides annual funding for arts education programs.

Mrs. Foggy-Paxton indicated that she attended two school site visit with other Board Members. She visited Environmental Charter School and City of Champions High School. She said it was a good visit where they had an opportunity to speak with students and teachers.

Mrs. Foggy-Paxton said that she attended a Marketing and Strategic Communications Committee for Inglewood. She said that there is now a plan in place to address facilities in Inglewood.

REPORT ON THE *RUSSELL WESTBROOK WHY NOT? CHARTERS* REQUIRED MID-TERM UPDATE

On February 9, 2021, the charters for Russell Westbrook Why Not? Middle School and Russell Westbrook Why Not? High School were renewed by the County Board. At the time of renewals, both schools were identified in the State's middle tier for performance. Without two years of state data, the high school was identified as such by default. As a condition of renewal for each school, the County Board required the charter schools to provide a mid-term update regarding performance on the California Dashboard Indicators as well as Measurable Pupil Outcomes.

Ms. Veronica Melvin, Chief Executive Officer of LA Promise Fund, the non-profit corporation and her team presented an update for each school regarding performance on the California Dashboard Indicators as well as Measurable Pupil Outcomes as required by the County Board on February 9, 2021.

The County Board had questions regarding this item.

High Performance Level Category

- The charter school has received the two highest performance levels schoolwide on all the state indicators included in the evaluation rubrics adopted pursuant to Section 52064.5 for which it receives performance levels.
- For all measurements of academic performance, the charter school has received performance levels schoolwide that are the same or higher than the state average and, for a majority of subgroups performing statewide below the state average in each respective year, received performance levels that are higher than the state average.

**Schools in technical assistance do not qualify.*

High Performance Level Category

- Education Code (EC) 47607(c)(2)(A). The chartering authority **shall not deny renewal** for a charter school pursuant to this subdivision...

High Performance Level Category

- Presumptive Renewal
- Streamlined Process

Low Performance Level Category

Low Performance Level Category

- EC 47607.2(a). The charter school authority may renew a charter in the low performance category if:
 - *The charter is taking meaningful steps to address the underlying causes of low performance and those steps are reflected, or will be reflected, in a written plan adopted by the governing board of the charter school*
 - *There is **clear and convincing evidence*** showing either:*
 - *The school achieved measurable increases in academic achievement as defined by at least one year's progress for each year in school*
 - *Strong post secondary outcomes as defines by college enrollment, persistence and completion rates equal to similar peers*

**These must be demonstrated by verifiable data.*

Low Performance Level Category

- Presumptive Denial
- May only apply for renewal with both:
 - Meaningful steps and a plan for improvement
 - Clear and convincing academic growth or post secondary outcomes
- 2 year term

Middle Performance Level Category

- EC 47607.2(b)(1). For all charter schools for which paragraph (2) of subdivision (c) of Section 47607 and subdivision (a) of this section do not apply...

Middle Performance Level Category

- EC 47607.2(b)(3). In addition to the state and local indicators, the chartering authority shall consider:
 - **Clear and convincing evidence*** *showing either:*
 - *The school achieved measurable increases in academic achievement as defined by at least one year's progress for each year in school*
 - *Strong post secondary outcomes as defines by college enrollment, persistence and completion rates equal to similar peers*

**These must be demonstrated by verifiable data.*

Middle Performance Level Category

- EC 47607.2(b)(2). The chartering authority shall provide greater weight to performance on measurements of academic performance in determining whether to grant a charter renewal.

Middle Performance Level Category

- Failed to meet or make sufficient progress toward meeting standards that provide a benefit to the pupils of the school.
- Closure of the charter school is in the best interest of pupils.
- The decision provided greater weight to performance on measurements of academic performance.

Middle Performance Level Category

- High level of review
- Greater weight on academic performance
- 5 year renewal term
- Additional findings for denial

Dashboard Alternative School Status (DASS)

- EC 47607(c)(7). Paragraph (2) and subdivisions (a) and (b) of Section 47607.2 shall not apply to a charter school that is eligible for alternate methods for calculating the state and local indicators...

Dashboard Alternative School Status (DASS)

- The chartering authority shall consider:
 - the charter school's performance on the state and local indicators
 - the charter school's performance on alternative metrics applicable to the charter school based on the pupil population served
- The chartering authority shall meet with the charter school to discuss alternative metrics to be considered and shall notify the charter school of the alternative metrics to be used.

Dashboard Alternative School Status (DASS)

- The chartering authority may deny a charter renewal pursuant to this paragraph only upon making written findings, setting forth specific facts to support the findings, that the closure of the charter school is in the best interest of pupils.

LACOE Process for Authorized Schools

- Renewal handbook and appendices documents
- Renewal meetings with authorized charter schools in the year prior to renewal
- Collaboration between school and coordinator for timelines
- Optional review of documents prior to submission



Review Challenges

- **Timeline compliance** when Board Meeting/Holidays/Capacity Interview date reduce timeline and petitioner may not agree to extension
- **Additional information** received after petition submission:
 - Information not part of district administrative record








The Need for AI Guidance





Item VI. Consent Calendar Recommendations

A. Approval for Disposal of Surplus E-Waste and Recycle Property

The Superintendent recommends that the County Board approve the disposal of public personal property. Surplus assets will be disposed of through e-waste, recycled, or public auction, whichever method is most constructive.

The volume of E-waste items on this list is the result of several divisions performing spring cleaning and consolidating office spaces. This work, combined with Technology Services efforts to refresh the network, have resulted in a large list of obsolete and damaged equipment for surplus.

Education Code Section 17545 authorizes the governing board to sell or dispose of surplus personal property. Any personal property not required for school purposes, unsuitable or unsatisfactory for school use or to be disposed of due to replacement, may be disposed in this manner. E-waste will be donated to *human-i-t*, an organization that recycles and sells parts and then utilizes funds to provide discounted new devices to low-income families.

E-waste and recycle property to be disposed of may include unusable:

- Equipment – Vehicles, Projectors, Typewriters, Fax Machines, Computers, Monitors, Printers, Camcorders, VCRs, Bulbs, Furniture, Stoves, Microwaves, and Old/Obsolete items, etc.

BOARD RESOLUTION

NO. 55: 2024-25

Recognize May as Jewish American Heritage Month

- WHEREAS,** Jewish American Heritage Month is observed in May each year to honor the contributions of Jewish Americans to the United States and to raise awareness of the rich heritage of the Jewish people; and
- WHEREAS,** there are an estimated 7.5 million Jewish Americans, with California being home to the second largest Jewish population in the United States;
- WHEREAS,** Jewish Americans represent a vibrant, diverse and multifaceted community with a rich heritage encompassing ancestry, culture, and traditions, as well as a range of religious practices and cultural traditions; and
- WHEREAS,** the diversity within the Jewish American community enriches our nation and adds to the vibrant tapestry of American life; and
- WHEREAS,** Jewish Americans have played a pivotal role in the history of the United States, contributing significantly in fields such as science, arts, literature, law, business, entertainment, government and military service; and
- WHEREAS,** Jewish American heritage is a part of the broader story of immigration, struggle, resilience, and respect for tradition that has been a cornerstone of the American experience; and
- WHEREAS,** the stories and accomplishments of Jewish Americans are essential to the narrative of our Nation and provide rich examples of commitment to faith, dedication to community, and contributions to national progress; and
- WHEREAS,** it is essential to honor and educate around the history, struggles and achievements of Jewish Americans; and
- WHEREAS,** On May 6th 2024 we took pause for Holocaust Remembrance Day, or Yom Hashoah in Hebrew, and remembered the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising and the six million Jews who were murdered by the Nazi regime and its allies during the Holocaust from 1943-1945.
- WHEREAS,** bias and discrimination, including anti-Semitism and anti-Jewish hate negatively impact the wellbeing and sense of belonging for diverse communities and our society as a whole;
- WHEREAS,** the Anti-Defamation League (ADL) reports that antisemitic incidents increased by 360 percent in the three months following the October 7th attack on Israel; and

WHEREAS, the Anti-Defamation League (ADL) reports that antisemitic incidents in Los Angeles increased by 198 percent from 2022 to 2023; and

WHEREAS, LACOE stands firmly and unwaveringly against antisemitism and any form of anti-Jewish hate; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Los Angeles County Board of Education recognizes May as Jewish American Heritage Month and encourages all schools and community members to recognize and celebrate the contributions of Jewish Americans to our nation's history and culture with appropriate programs and activities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that LACOE encourages educational leaders to observe this month with appropriate instructional activities, including teaching students about the contributions of Jewish Americans, understanding their historical challenges and celebrating their achievements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that LACOE supports schools in organizing and endorsing activities that honor and celebrate Jewish American heritage, thereby promoting diversity and cultural understanding in our schools and community.

AB 2711 (Ramos) Suspensions and expulsions: tobacco: alcohol: drug paraphernalia. [Amended: 4/29/2024]

Recommended Position: **Support**

Background Information: Existing law prohibits a pupil from being suspended from school or recommended for expulsion, unless the superintendent of the school district or the principal of the school in which the pupil is enrolled determines that the pupil has committed a specified act, including that the pupil (1) unlawfully possessed, used, sold, or otherwise furnished, or had been under the influence of, a controlled substance, an alcoholic beverage, or an intoxicant of any kind, (2) possessed or used tobacco, or products containing tobacco or nicotine products, including cigarettes, cigars, miniature cigars, clove cigarettes, smokeless tobacco, snuff, chew packets, and betel, or (3) unlawfully possessed drug paraphernalia. Existing law requires suspension to only be imposed when other means of correction, as provided, fail to bring about proper conduct and authorizes a

school district to document the other means of correction used and place that documentation in the pupil's record.

This bill would, commencing July 1, 2026, require the following conditions to be met before suspending a pupil, regardless of their grade of enrollment, from school on the basis of (1) unlawfully possessing, using, or being under the influence of a controlled substance, an alcoholic beverage, or an intoxicant of any kind or (2) having possessed or used tobacco products, and would remove unlawfully possessing drug paraphernalia from the list of acts for which a pupil may be suspended:

- a) The student is provided with two opportunities for supportive interventions, as specified in the school's adopted plan;
- b) After two documented unsuccessful interventions, the student may be suspended; and
- c) A student may be removed from campus for the day who is under the influence of a controlled substance, an alcoholic beverage, or an intoxicant of any kind, provided that the student is excused due to illness.

The bill would, commencing July 1, 2026, require these conditions to be met before suspending a charter school pupil in kindergarten or any of grades 1 to 12, inclusive, solely on the basis of (1) unlawfully possessing, using, or being under the influence of a controlled substance, an alcoholic beverage, or an intoxicant of any kind, or (2) having possessed or used tobacco products.

This bill would, commencing July 1, 2026, remove those three acts described above from the list of acts for which a pupil, regardless of their grade of enrollment, may be recommended for expulsion for, unless it is determined that a pupil's unlawful possession of a controlled substance presents an imminent risk of harm to other pupils or school staff. The bill would, commencing July 1, 2026, prohibit a charter school pupil in kindergarten or any of grades 1 to 12, inclusive, from being recommended for expulsion solely on the basis of (1) unlawfully possessing, using, or being under the influence of a controlled substance, an alcoholic beverage, or an intoxicant of any kind, or (2) having possessed or used tobacco products, unless it is determined that a pupil's unlawful possession of a controlled substance presents an imminent risk of harm to other pupils or school staff.

The bill would instead require a school district to document the other means of correction used before suspending a pupil, and would expressly include as another means of correction the enrollment in a substance use or mental health prevention, treatment, or services program or a tobacco cessation program.

By imposing additional duties on school districts, the bill would impose a state-mandated local program. The bill would encourage school districts, county offices of education, and charter schools to implement campuswide programs and activities that provide mentoring and school counseling to all pupils, including pupils who are at risk of drug use and abuse.

LACOE Subject Matter Experts: The following LACOE divisions reviewed the bill and provided the following comments for a recommendation of support:

Curriculum and Instructional: The bill's mandate for school districts to establish a public health framework for identifying and supporting youth with substance use issues will empower administrators with enhanced resources and decision-making capabilities to refer students to community-based services. This proactive approach grants administrator's greater flexibility beyond resorting solely to punitive measures like suspension and expulsions. By addressing the health needs of students involved in substance possession and use incidents, the bill aims to mitigate the risk of future substance abuse and addiction, thereby promoting a more holistic and effective response to youth substance-related challenges.

Services Student Support Services: As K-12 students struggle with managing increased feelings of anxiety and social connections to school, recent findings have indicated that many children and youth are accessing illicit substances to regulate themselves when faced with uncomfortable emotions. Data from the 2019-2020 California Healthy Kids Survey (CHKS) suggests that 10 percent of 9th-grade students and 17 percent of 11th-grade students who experienced chronic sadness self-reported having used marijuana within the last 30 days.

There continues to be a strong need for more substance use prevention services focusing on efforts to minimize substance use initiation that could lead to addiction. As the adolescent brain does not fully develop until the age of 25, prevention programs are designed to increase protective factors and reduce risk factors that can lead to drug use. AB 2711 provides an opportunity to better support K-12 students by expanding prevention, early intervention, and treatment services. In such a critical time with the fentanyl crisis impacting our Los Angeles County communities, AB 2711 will assist in eliminating barriers to better support our students and approach the issue with a health equity lens.

Currently, children and youth presenting on school campuses in possession of, or under the influence of, controlled substances, alcohol, or tobacco are subject to punitive disciplinary practices such as suspension or recommendation for expulsion. In most instances, removing a student from the instructional environment may further create feelings of isolation and shame, ineffectively addressing the root cause of the student's substance use. AB 2711 prohibits students from being suspended or recommended for expulsion for unlawfully possessing, using, or being deemed to be under the influence of a controlled substance, an alcoholic beverage, or an intoxicant. Furthermore, this legislation would remove possessing or using tobacco or products containing tobacco or nicotine from the list of acts for which a student may be suspended or recommended for expulsion.

AB 2711 presents a call to action, requiring districts, county offices of education, and charter schools to develop a youth-informed prevention and intervention plan delineating accessible school-based and community resources to address the underlying needs of students who use or possess such products on campus. Recommended community resources included in the plan and protocols are to undergo a proper vetting process to ensure that the interests of students and families at the center. The proposed legislation also indicates protocols to be included in the plan, outlining measures taken after an incident involving a pupil using or possessing tobacco, a controlled substance, or alcohol on school property.

Additionally, AB 2711 intends to circumvent exclusionary practices that have disproportionately affected students of color, students with disabilities, or students impacted by poverty. 2022-23 California data indicates that African American students represented 5.12 percent of the cumulative enrollment; however, this student group had a suspension rate of 8.9 percent. Similarly, in that same year, Native American or Alaskan Native students represented .45 percent of the California cumulative enrollment with a suspension rate of 7.5 percent.

AB 2845 (Rivas, R.) Migrant education: California Mini-Corps program and currently migratory children. [Amended: 4/29/2024]

Recommended Position: **Support**

Background Information: Existing law establishes the State Department of Education under the administration of the Superintendent of Public Instruction. Existing law assigns numerous duties and responsibilities to the department, including the management of the federally funded Migrant Education Program (MEP), which includes the California Mini-Corps (CMC) program, a statewide program designed to provide direct instructional services for currently migratory children in kindergarten and grades 1 to 12, inclusive, through a cadre of trained college tutors with the goals of increasing currently migratory children's academic achievement and developing future bilingual-bicultural, credentialed teachers.

This bill would codify the CMC program and would require the department to annually select one county office of education to voluntarily administer the CMC program for the next fiscal year and would require the chosen county office of education to operate not less than 20 program sites at institutions of higher education. The bill would require the Commission on Teacher Credentialing to, on or before July 31 of each year, report to the chosen county office of education the number of tutors from the prior fiscal year's cohort who subsequently enrolled in an educator preparation program or who subsequently earned a preliminary teaching credential. The bill would require the department to, on or before December 1 of each year, provide an annual report to the Legislature and the Department of Finance that includes the number of currently migratory children served by the program statewide and includes the data reported by the commission. The bill would require the department to annually report on its internet website the total number of migrant children statewide.

LACOE Subject Matter Experts: The following LACOE division reviewed the bill and provided the following comments for a recommendation of support:

Accountability, Support, and Monitoring: The state would provide additional funds for the implementation of the CMC Program which could potentially increase the number of college tutors who provide free tutoring support for LACOE MEP students. The summer Outdoor Education program offered by CMC Program is excellent and LACOE students have participated consistently for years. This additional funding may result in an increase of Outdoor Education offerings to LACOE MEP students.

SB 1383 (Bradford) California Advanced Services Fund: Broadband Public Housing Account. [Amended: 4/9/2024]

Recommended Position: **Support**

Background Information: Existing law requires the Public Utilities Commission to establish the Broadband Public Housing Account in the California Advanced Services Fund and makes the moneys in the account available to the commission to award grants to low-income communities to finance projects to connect broadband networks that offer free broadband service that meets or exceeds state standards for residents of low-income communities.

This bill would make moneys in the account available instead for grants and loans to finance projects to connect broadband networks that offer broadband service for residents of low-income communities and would revise the requirement that the broadband service be free to require certain grantees to provide residential subscribers within low-income communities with a free or low-cost broadband internet access service plan. The bill would authorize the commission to make grants to support the deployment of network devices to

address barriers to consistent deployment of broadband services in a low-income community. The bill would specify that the requirement to provide a free or low-cost broadband internet access service plan does not apply to a grantee that is awarded grants for the sole purpose of deployment network devices to improve broadband services.

Under existing law, a violation of the Public Utilities Act or an order, decision, rule, direction, demand, or requirement of the commission is a crime.

Because the requirement related to the provision of a free or low-cost broadband internet access service plan would be a part of the act and a violation of a commission action implementing that requirement would be a crime, this bill would impose a state-mandated local program.

LACOE Subject Matter Experts: The following LACOE division reviewed the bill and provided the following comments for a recommendation of support:

Technology Infrastructure Services: This bill strengthens the goal of the Delete the Divide initiative. This bill can favorably finance projects that offer broadband to socioeconomically disadvantaged communities.
