Want your students to love history? Then History Day L.A. is the program for you!

History Day motivates students to discover history by:

- Cultivating interest: students research a topic of their choice
- Developing research skills: students act as historians discovering how to uncover primary sources, build historical context and form historical interpretations
- Becoming experts on their research topic: presenting their research to teachers, students, and historians
- Achieving success
  - The shy student gains confidence when speaking about a topic he/she has researched
  - The apathetic student gains passion by choosing a topic of personal interest
  - The high achieving student increases his/her ability to articulate their learning through presentation



Winners of the History Day L.A. contest will be eligible to compete at the National History Day – California contest. State winners move on to the National History Day Contest at the University of Maryland at College Park in June. This is where the best National History projects from across the United States, American Samoa, Guam, International Schools and Department of Defense Schools in Europe all meet and compete.

#### Number of Entries Permitted for History Day L.A.

There is NO limit on the number of entries allowed per category.

#### **Register for History Day L.A.**

Registration for History Day LA is conducted online by teachers. The link can be found on the History Day L.A. web page at <u>https://www.lacoe.edu/about/events/history-day-la</u>

Teachers are required to submit information for all student projects. Once the "Submit" button is pushed a window with additional information will appear including a History Day L.A. Student Affidavit that must be signed by each participating student and parent/guardian.

- **Registration Fee:** All entries must include a purchase order, school check or money order payable to Los Angeles County Office of Education to cover registration fee of **\$60.00 per student** for every student registering. Personal checks will not be accepted.
- Important Deadlines:
  - Friday, January 26, 2024: Deadline to Register Students
  - Friday, February 16, 2024: Deadline to Submit Payment and Student Affidavit(s). It is also the deadline to submit any Historical Papers for entry.
