To demonstrate understanding of how human trafficking affects Native American populations and identification of victimization in Native American youth.

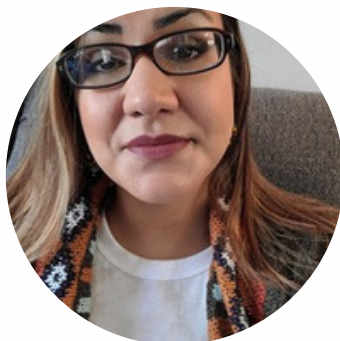
To learn how to provide support to Native American youth survivors of human trafficking from a trauma-informed, victim-centered, and culturally relevant perspective.
