## What is Phishing?


Phishing is one of many types of cybercrimes in which an attacker contacts a victim through email, phone, or text, pretending to be a trustworthy individual, to obtain sensitive information or data, such as log in username and passwords. Phishing attacks will usually ask for information such as:

- Date of Birth
- Social Security Number
- Phone Number
- Credit Card Details
- Bank Details
- Username and Password

### **RedHerring Features**


#### Campaigns:

Campaigns allow organizations to test staff by sending emails over a period of time or all at once. Campaigns can be customized to use custom emails and landing pages. It features a quick and easy form to fill out and begin the campaign.



#### Email Template Library:

Choose from the library of email templates for various phishing emails such as spear phishing, social engineering, spoofing, online scams, and credential harvesting.



#### **Advanced Metrics:**

Our metrics allow you to see which users clicked on a phishing link and dive into the history of a particular user or group of users. These metrics will later include which users attempted to log in to a simulated phishing site, viewed a training video, and/or completed the optional awareness quizzes. Metrics also allow for report generation to present data to staff and board members.
